Mill Creek Village (MCV) is a charitable, nonprofit community service organization of volunteers willing to give their time and effort to help their elderly neighbors (60 years of age and older) to maintain their independence and "age in place."

Since 2013, MCV volunteers have demonstrated compassionate support for older neighbors in need. We also have worked to foster a caring, socially connected community across all ages by hosting annual inter-generational neighborhood events and activities.

Among the services we offer are:

- Transportation to doctor and other appointments;
- Grocery shopping and some meal preparation;
- Friendly home visits, regular phone contacts;
- A bi-weekly electronic community newsletter;
- Community-wide social events: and,
- A Welcome Wagon for new neighbors.

Transportation

In association with the Senior Connection, local volunteer drivers are available for up to FOUR (4) escorted round trips per month, per client to a pre-scheduled appointment.

Acceptable appointments include:

- Medical appointments
- Pharmacies for medication
- Senior, social and recreation activities
- Religious services
- Trips to the bank or post office
- Grocery shopping*

Home and Phone Visits

Volunteers visit with and call elderly neighbors to monitor health and well-being and reduce social isolation and loneliness. These friendly visits boost their spirits and let them know their neighbors genuinely care.
